



72" Hex Table Assembly Instructions Model #s: B264040, B264042, B2331053






Step 3


Align the pre-drilled holes in the seats and support arms, attach using 3 1/2" hex lag screws and flat washers.

Installation Tip: Seats may fit tigthly side by side, tilt the seats up slightly as you tighten lag screws to pull them down flush against the support arms.



Step 4


Position the assembled seats and support arms assembly approximately 10" to 15" above the floor. Tip: A five gallon bucket under the center point of the assembly works well.



Step 5


The three (3) base support legs are rotated for shipping purposes. A single deck screw is pre-installed, rotate the leg 90 degrees and align the pre-drilled holes. Secure the leg with a supplied deck screw. Repeat for all three (3) legs.

IMPORTANT NOTE FOR THE NEXT STEPS: DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN LAG BOLTS. DO NOT LEAN ON TABLE TOP OR SEATS WHEN ASSEMBLING.




Step 6

Insert a base support in the open space of each of the three (3) support arms, centering each leg on the pre-drilled countersunk holes of the support arms. Attach the base support uprights to the seat blocks with 2 1/2" hex lag screws and flat washers. Ensure the seats are centered with the support arms.



Step 7

With two people, carefully lift the table top and position the slots in the top underside frame with the three (3) uprights. Slide the top down onto the uprights. Ensure each upright is fully engaged in the slot and the top is resting even and level.



Step 8

Attach each upright to the table top using a 3 1/2" hex lag screw and flat washer, tighten fully. Hex head should be within the countersunk hole. Attach all three (3) support arms to the base uprights at the pre-drilled holes using a 3 1/2" hex lag screw and flat washer.
