

ASSEMBLY




- 1) Mount left (#1) and right (#2) uprights to the base plate (#3) using 4, ½" x 1 ½" long bolts, 8 flat washers and 4 nylock nuts. (NOTE: Do not tighten bolts all the way, so the jack assembly can be installed).
- 2) Place control levers (#10 & #11) in the "UP" position and then remove the face plate from the jack assembly.
- 3) Insert the tongue of jack into left (uncapped) upright with Jack Mounting bracket, on UNDER SIDE of uprights. (See Assembly Instruction Detail) and assemble with a ½" x 3 ½" bolt on the right, and a ½" x 4 ½" long bolt on the left, 4 flat washers and 2 nylock nuts.
- Align the uprights and ram assembly and tighten all bolts. Install the face plate back onto the jack assembly.
- 5) Mount the circular ram plate (#6) to the jack assembly (#5) using the ½" x 2 ½" bolt and nylock nut in the ram plate.

1) To operate the Pack-Master, engage the handle lock as shown.



2) Swing the lower lever to the "DOWN" position first, and then the upper lever to the "DOWN" position.





3) Disengage the <u>handle lock</u> and then begin pumping the jack handle up and down.



4) To retract the compactor plate, while applying slight downward pressure on jack handle, swing upper lever to "UP" position, then the lower lever. This removes pressure on the pin and will extend the life of the jacking pins.

- The Pack-Master is not designed for crushing of glass containers or items that may shatter or contain volatile vapors.
- DO NOT extend or modify the handle in any way.
- DO NOT permanently bolt the Pack-Master to the floor as damage and breakage of ram assembly and personal injury may occur.
- ALWAYS hold on to the jack handle while compacting. Jack handle may "SPRING" up when under load and pins have not snapped all the way in to the jack rail.
- ALWAYS engage the handle lock when moving the levers, or the jack handle may fall suddenly, causing injury.
- ALWAYS keep your head out of the path of the jack handle!




