

Standard And ESD Laminate Cleaning.

Laminates provide a durable surface that is easy to maintain using ordinary care. To maintain the laminate's lasting beauty, cleaning with a solution of warm water and liquid detergent is all that should be required in most cases.

To Disinfect a laminate work surface.

- Diluted household bleach solutions can be used for the surface.
 - Use bleach containing 5.25–8.25% sodium hypochlorite. Do not use a bleach product if the percentage is not in this range or is not specified.
 - Follow the manufacturer's application instructions for the surface, ensuring a contact time of at least 1 minute.
 - Ensure proper ventilation during and after application.
 - Check to ensure the product is not past its expiration date.
 - Never mix household bleach with ammonia or any other cleanser. This can cause fumes that may be very dangerous to breathe in.
- Prepare a bleach solution by mixing:
 - 5 tablespoons (1/3rd cup) of 5.25–8.25% bleach per gallon of room temperature water or
 - 4 teaspoons of 5.25–8.25% bleach per quart of room temperature water
- Bleach solutions will be effective for disinfection up to 24 hours.
- Bleach solutions should not be left to stand longer than 1 1/2 minutes.
- Rinse Bleach solutions thoroughly with warm water and wipe dry.
- Alcohol solutions with at least 70% alcohol may also be used.
- Non-Abrasive commercial wipes may also be used.
- DO NOT USE ABRASIVE CLEANERS.
