


Aluminum Power Strip

BACK MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS (Steps 1 & 2)



Fix the back mount brackets (H1) onto the mounting location using two self tapping screws (H2) for each bracket, making sure that all are on the same center line. Determine the bracket spacing by the length of the power strip keeping the brackets 4 to 8" from the ends of the power strip. Once back mount brackets are attached slide the power strip in place.



SIDE MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS (Steps 3 & 4)

Side mount brackets are mostly used in cabinets and ship with 4 phillips oval head screws (H4). Slide one bracket on each side of the power strip and then align with predrilled holes in cabinet and tighten.

CAUTION:
Do not expose a power strip or power cord to a moist environment. Do not use power strip if power cord has frayed, exposed or has damaged wires. Do not cover power strip or power cord with carpet, furniture, rugs, newspapers, clothing or any other item. Do not staple or tack power strips or power cord. Visually inspect Power strip and cord on a regular basis to ensure that they are not damaged or showing sign of degradation. Insert plugs fully into the outlet so that no part of the prongs or the plug is exposed.
