Have a forklift? Let it do the drum handling.

Mechanical attachments turn any forklift into a drum handler: beak, strap, and jaw styles up to 1,500 lb with no power required. Powered attachments go further, clamping, lifting, tilting, rotating, and dumping 2,000 lb drums 100% from the seat, so the operator never climbs down to free a latch or pull a chain.

No forklift? Stop putting four backs on one drum.

Muscling a 500 lb drum takes a crew: four people, one injury waiting to happen, and three jobs sitting idle. A Drum Lift & Rotator lets one operator pick a drum off a pallet, carry it, and pour with 360° control. 78 in. and 90 in. models, manual to fully powered. For fixed stations, Drum Dumpers run on standard 110V.

Drums arrive four to a pallet? Send each one where it belongs.

One of the most common drum jobs in any plant: four drums arrive on one pallet, and each needs to go somewhere different. A Drum Lift & Transporter reaches onto the pallet, lifts the drum straight off, and wheels it to its point of use. One operator, no prying, tipping, or rolling. Beak, strap, or cylinder grips; 800 lb.
